


## About Dr. Maggy Maher

## EXAM

Both Year 9 & 10 students are examined on 3 papers. Each paper asks questions in different ways and takes a certain percentage from the whole grade.



#### Core assessment

Core candidates take Paper 1 and Paper 3. The questions are based on the Core subject content only.



Notes with detailed explanations of all lessons. Updated to latest 2023 syllabus


### **Classified Past Papers**
